**ALPAMANTA, MENDOZA**



The 35 hectares vineyard is located at the Calle Cobos in Ugarteche, the southern part of Luján de Cuyo, 38 kms south of Mendoza city. The 3 year old vineyard are trained in V.S.P (Vertical Shooting Position) and give a 5 - tone yield per hectare. The young vines consist of 50 % Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot and 15% of whites such as Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc.

Alluvional soils of lime texture, mineral and poor in organic matter with excellent drainage in an area of low annual rainfall, make the ideal conditions for grape growing. Pesticides are not used at all through the cycle. Maceration started at cold temperature previous to fermentation. Once alcoholic fermentation (using exclusively native yeasts) was completed at 26°C, a post-fermenting maceration took place over the next 7 days, making a total of 28 tank days.

**ANTUCURA, MENDOZA VISTA FLORES**

Antucurá means “Sun Stone” and Calvucura means “Blue Stone” in old Mapudungun language. Mapudungun (mapu means 'earth' and dungun means 'to speak') was the language used by the Pehuenches, the first inhabitants of the area where the Antucurá winery stands today in the Uco Valley in Argentina. The owners chose that name for their winery and vineyards because the grapes grow and develop naturally between the stones and rocks. The winery sits below the Andes Mountains using ancient viniculture traditions and new vinification technologies, to produce premium wines.

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**ARGENTINA CUVELIER LOS ANDES, TUNUYAN - MENDOZA**

The vineyard was planted in 1999 with a density of 5500 plants per hectare. This is a similar density to those favored in Bordeaux but is rare in Argentina. Today the vineyard stretches over 55 hectares (136 acres) with 10 hectares still to plant. The main grape is Malbec. They have also planted Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah and Petit Verdot. This enables them to create their own blended wines and also contribute to those of Clos de los Siete. Basking in the warm, dry climate of Mendoza, cooled by the refreshing night air of the Andes, their vines are ideally situated to express the character of their various grape varieties in this stony, alluvial gravel soil.

**CANADA CLOS DU SOLEIL, OKANAGAN VALLEY**

“We are developing wines that have that old world elegance, but with a bit of a new world edge and oomph” say managing directors Les and Spencer, “after all, we are Canadian and our vineyard is in BC”. In 2009 Ann Sperling, renowned Canadian winemaker and a former high school classmate of Spencer, joined as viticulturist and winemaker, and Spencer Kelly joined as associate winemaker and vineyard manager. The name Clos du Soleil refers to rocks, sun, and soil, from the mountain that forms a tall natural stone wall at the back of the vineyard, the cobbled terroir, and the long days of sun which pour in on the Similkameen Bench, one of BC’s most unique and promising microclimates.

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Descended from a long line of wine growers passing down from father to son, Charles Audoin took over the family property in 1972 with his wife Marie-Françoise, an oenologist by training. Located within the commune of Marsannay-la-Côte, the estate stretches over almost 35 acres, and the diversity of soils and grapes makes it possible to produce a range of fourteen different wines.

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Domaine Hubert de Montille is a first class Côte de Beaune domaine and one which is producing some of the purest expressions of Pinot Noir to be found in Burgundy today. The winemaking is traditional - partial destemming followed by a relatively long maceration period. Crucially, chapitalisation is kept to a bare minimum. The wines are aged in oak barriques (20-30% new) and are bottled unfiltered. These are wonderfully elegant, harmonious wines that require at least five years bottle ageing to show at their very best

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This is the greatest estate in Burgundy...How do you determine great? Is it size? Is it quality? Is it price? Is it "reputation" (what ever that is)? Is it the amount of media coverage? However you do compute it, the greatest domaines of Burgundy today must be those under the control of Lalou Bize : The Domaine Leroy and her own Domaine d'Auvenay. The estates of Jadot, Faiveley and Bouchard Père & Fils are far larger, that of Romanée-Conti the most splendid in terms of percentage of grand terroir, but for nobility of it's wines, pride of place must go to Leroy and to the Domaine d'Auvenay. The sheer concentration, depth and intensity Lalou Bize manages to squeeze into her bottles is breathtaking". Clive COATES M.W.

**JEAN-PAUL & BENOIT DROIN, CHABLIS - BURGUNDY**



The Droin family is amongst the oldest in Chablis, its members having been wine growers for nearly five centuries. Since the year of 1620, fourteen generations of vigneronns have transmitted their "savoir-faire" down from father to son. The domaine's extensive premier and grand cru holdings span the entire range of the Chablis stylistic repertory. From mineral La Montée de Tonnerre, Vaudésir and Les Clos to fruitier and softer-textured Vaillons, La Fourchaume and Valmur, with Montmains somewhere in between adding citrus and floral notes, site specific nuances of flavour (and Chablis is all about nuances) are accurately translated into bottle.

**BILLECART-SALMON, CHAMPAGNE**

Billecart-Salmon is frequently cited for the quality of its cuvées. This originates from the great attention paid to the choice of grapes together with the partnership of the wine growers. They works some 30 hectares itself and is supplied by grapes from a total area of 140 hectares in 35 individual crus. Ninety per-cent of the grapes come from a radius of 20km around Epernay, where the greatest vineyards are concentrated.

The domain has 8,5 ha. in Chateauneuf du Pape. It was founded by Claude's great grandfather. About 1900 his grandfather was one of few in the town to bottle the wine calling it Clos Courtil. Until 1996 a great part of the production was sold to negociants. Claude's uncle is the legendary Henri Bonneau, one of the most revered winemakers in Châteauneuf-du-Pape. The relationship between Claude and Henri is strong as he is not only his uncle but his master as well. Claude learned everything from his uncle.

**CLOS SAINT-JEAN, CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, RHONE VALLEY**



If you haven't caught on to the exquisite quality of Clos Saint-Jean's Chateauneuf du Papes, now is the time ... Robert Parker, Jr – The Wine Advocate – Feb/07. The Maurel brothers, Vincent and Pascal, watch over this 43-hectare estate and sell off almost two-thirds of their production, choosing to focus on their old vines for their estate bottlings. The Combe des Fous, according to Vincent, is named for "how foolish the village thought Edmond Tacussel was when he planted this steep section of La Crau at the beginning of the 20th century. It has turned out great for us to have these vines, of course, because La Crau is always very fresh, with excellent body. But also-and this is important-it's fine." These are big, full-flavored wines, no doubt the result of macerations that typically last five weeks, or even more. The grenache, which usually comprises around 60% of the blends, is always raised without wood.

### EMILIO MORO, RIBERA DEL DUERO



The history of the bodega goes back three generations; Emilio Moro was born in the heart of the Pesquera wine-growing area and grew up treading grapes and racking wine in his native village of Pesquera de Duero, in the province of Valladolid. As early as 14 years old, Emilio helped his father sell 100 large earthenware pitchers of wine to local clients. Years later, after being initiated into the techniques of wine growing by his father, Don Emilio planted vines on the rest of his land and grafted them with 100 year-old local Tempranillo "Tinto Fino", coming from estates which have now disappeared, such as "La Rendeja"

The 1992 vintage, through a combination of very low production numbers and highly positive reviews (wine critic Robert Parker awarded the wine 99 points. In 2006 the estate was sold to Santa Barbara businessmen Charles Banks and Stanley Kroenke. In an ongoing replanting strategy, the vineyard manager David Abreu is employed to oversee the process. The vineyards are tended by viticulturist Annie Favia and vineyard foreman Jorge Delgado, while the current winemaker is Andy Erickson. In April 2009, Banks stated he was no longer involved with Screaming Eagle. The vineyard area extends 60 acres (24 ha), planted with varieties Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc. The annual production ranges from 400 to 600 cases a year.
