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ARGENTINA ALPAMANTA, MENDOZA

The 35 hectares vineyard is located at the Calle Cobos in Ugarteche, the southern part of Luján de Cuyo, 38 kms south of Mendoza city. The 3 year old vineyard are trained in V.S.P (Vertical Shooting Position) and give a 5 - tone yield per hectare. The young vines consist of 50 % Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot and 15% of whites such as Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc.

Alluvional soils of lime texture, mineral and poor in organic matter with excellent drainage in an area of low annual rainfall, make the ideal conditions for grape growing. Pesticides are not used at all through the cycle. Maceration started at cold temperature previous to fermentation. Once alcoholic fermentation (using exclusively native yeasts) was completed at 26°C, a post-fermenting maceration took place over the next 7 days, making a total of 28 tank days.

Andeluna is dedicated to creating world-class wines, and the world is taking notice. They were recently named with one of the “Top 100 Wines of the World” by Wine Enthusiast, 2006.

ARGENTINA ANTUCURA, MENDOZA VISTA FLORES

Antucurá means “Sun Stone” and Calvucura means “Blue Stone” in old Mapudungun language. Mapudungun (mapu means 'earth' and dungun means 'to speak') was the language used by the Pehuenches, the first inhabitants of the area where the Antucurá winery stands today in the Uco Valley in Argentina. The owners chose that name for their winery and vineyards because the grapes grow and develop naturally between the stones and rocks. The winery sits below the Andes Mountains using ancient viticulture traditions and new vinification technologies, to produce premium wines.

ARGENTINA BODEGA DEL DESIERTO, LA PAMPA

The winery and vineyards are located in the town of 25 de Mayo, Puelén, La Pampa, on the western border of the desert route to Patagonia, Argentina. The 140 hectares of vineyard are planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Syrah, Pinot Noir, Malbec, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc and Viognier. The vines are irrigated by a dripping system which is fed from a 35-million-liter reservoir in the estate. The climate is dry, continental with moderate to cool temperatures, a thermal amplitude of 26° C and annual precipitations of 220 mm. The vineyard is located at 340 meters above sea level. The American winemaker **Paul Hobbs** is in charge of all consulting activities. 25/5, named after the town where the winery is located, is the first of three lines of wine which the winery will commercialize. In 2006, the varietal line of 25/5 will be launched. Bodega del Desierto is the first winery in the province of La Pampa, a new viticulture area.

ARGENTINA VINA ALICIA, MENDOZA

Viña Alicia operates much as you would expect a boutique, high-end winery to operate. The vineyards are farmed for very low yields (partially guaranteed by vine density) and harvest is done completely by hand in several passes through the vineyard, sometimes over weeks, to ensure only perfect ripe clusters of grapes are picked. The grapes are hand sorted and then most often hand destemmed using a special latticework table developed by the family for this purpose. The wines are fermented in small lots, specific to vineyard blocks, with natural yeasts whenever possible, and bottled without filtration and with only a light fining using egg whites. Some of the Malbec and the Cabernet are actually fermented in French oak, in addition to being aged in it.

FRANCE DOMAINE HUBERT DE MONTILLE, BURGUNDY

Domaine Hubert de Montille is a first class Côte de Beaune domaine and one which is producing some of the purest expressions of Pinot Noir to be found in Burgundy today. The winemaking is traditional - partial destemming followed by a relatively long maceration period. Crucially, chaptalisation is kept to a bare minimum. The wines are aged in oak barriques (20-30% new) and are bottled unfiltered. These are wonderfully elegant, harmonious wines that require at least five years bottle ageing to show at their very best.

Etienne de Montille and his sister Alix have created a small négociant operation under the play-on-words name Maison Deux Montille Soeur et Frère. It specializes in whites and is committed, whenever possible, to buying only grapes and not must and in 2005, Etienne said that 90% of the production was indeed bought in as grapes. New oak was limited to 15% at the villages level and 20% for the rest and as usual, they were not chaptalized.

FRANCE MAISON LEROY, BURGUNDY

This is the greatest estate in Burgundy...How do you determine great? Is it size? Is it quality? Is it price? Is it "reputation" (what ever that is)? Is it the amount of media coverage? However you do compute it, the greatest domaines of Burgundy today must be those under the control of Lalou Bize : The Domaine Leroy and her own Domaine d'Auvenay. The estates of Jadot, Faiveley and Bouchard Père & Fils are far larger, that of Romanée-Conti the most splendid in terms of percentage of grand terroir, but for nobility of it's wines, pride of place must go to Leroy and to the Domaine d'Auvenay. FRANCE DOMAINE DU CHATEAU PULIGNY-MONTRACHET, BURGUNDY

Château de Puligny-Montrachet was a slumbering force until finally been awoken by the arrival of Etienne de Montille in time to oversee the 2001 vintage. Under Etienne, yields have been drastically reduced and the wines are handled much more sympathetically in the cellar so that the quality of the fruit dominates the oak. The organic domaine encompasses 20 hectares of vineyards of which 2/3 is planted with Chardonnay and 1/3 is planted with Pinot Noir.

Though you might not be completely familiar with the name, Boisset are the largest négociant in Burgundy and in addition to the domaines amalgamated to form La Vougeraie, are the ultimate holding company of, possibly more familiar names, such as; Bouchard Aîné, Jaffelin, Ropiteau and Mommessin. With respect to La Vougeraie, the Boisset strategy was to create a domaine to compete at the highest level with the 'stars' of Burgundy.

And he earned these descriptions simply by following his nose for quality and by delving a little deeper than other Burgundian growers of Chardonnay into their winemaking tradition. Thevenet came to believe that the great Chardonnays of the Cote d'Or, as well as great wines from Macon were once routinely the result of organic farming and also of picking selectively in a manner now more familiar in the Loire, Sauternes, or for that matter Germany's Rheingau.

FRANCE	JEAN-PAUL & BENOIT DROIN, CHABLIS - BURGUNDY
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The Droin family is amongst the oldest in Chablis, its members having been wine growers for nearly five centuries. Since the year of 1620, fourteen generations of vignerons have transmitted their "savoir-faire" down from father to son. The domaine's extensive premier and grand cru holdings span the entire range of the Chablis stylistic repertory. From mineral La Montée de Tonnerre, Vaudésir and Les Clos to fruitier and softer-textured Vaillons, La Fourchaume and Valmur, with Montmains somewhere in between adding citrus and floral notes, site specific nuances of flavour (and Chablis is all about nuances) are accurately translated into bottle.

FRANCE	LEOPOLD GOURMEL, COGNAC
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Leopold Gourmel has a clear and logical vision. Aromatic wines should, first, be elaborated from matured grapes, full of fresh and fruity flavors, the original vineyard in the heart of Premier Crus Fins Bois and the ones further selected by Leopold Gourmel excel in this respect. Carefully vinified on lees, the wines are distilled so as to respect their origin in the vineyard. Each year different, the distillation always extracts and concentrates a pure fresh, simple spirit with the highest possible aromatic expression. Aged in oak cask with a fine grain, never blending vintages or vineyards, Leopold Gourmel cognacs slowly evolved through 5 typical stages.

SPAIN **EMILIO MORO, RIBERA DEL DUERO**

As early as 14 years old, Emilio helped his father sell 100 large earthenware pitchers of wine to local clients. Years later, after being initiated into the techniques of wine growing by his father, Don Emilio planted vines on the rest of his land and grafted them with 100 year-old local Tempranillo "Tinto Fino", coming from estates which have now disappeared, such as "La Rendeja"

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Distinctive wines can only come from outstanding fruit which is limited to certain unique sites and microclimates. Grapes from these sources do not require a lot of manipulation and have the greatest potential to produce the most exciting wines on the market today. They have the good fortune to work with some of the best growers anywhere who are pleased when their grapes do not disappear in massive blends.
